SUMMARY OF MEETING OF  
FEBRUARY 9, 2009

**\*Summary of the meeting due to the recording device not working**

Attendance: Commissioners Kuhlman, Brown and Klobukowski. Also in attendance was Alan Wright, Town Attorney and John Strong, Town Engineer.

The meeting was called to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was said.

There was a presentation of a Battle Flag presented to the Commissioners for Paul Kelly by Roger Strippey.

There were no minutes to be approved.

**St. Peter's Bond Release:** John Strong from Huron Consulting, based on field observation conducted on February 9, 2009, recommended the following Letter of Credits be released:

Work in Public Space in the sum of \$1,200.00

Grading Permit in the sum of \$108,672.50

Paving Permit in the sum of \$17,500.00

Water and Sewer Construction Permit in the amount of \$36,970.00

He also recommended that the Storm Drain Systems Construction Permit Letter of Credit should remain in place until the final sign off by Montgomery County.

**Fisher Avenue Streetscape:** John Strong from Huron Consulting briefed the Commissioners on the Fisher Avenue Streetscape Plan. A request was made for additional information for break down of costs for various segments of this project. Mr. Klobukowski requested a price for burying the power lines on Fisher Avenue.

**Septic Systems & Private Wells:** A discussion about the septic systems and private wells in the Town was conducted. Further discussion with staff will take place to identify the requirements to bring the septic systems and private wells into the Town's systems.
